

# **The European Landscape Convention**

""Landscape" means an area, as perceived by people, whose character is the result of the action and interaction of natural and/or human factors;"



# **The European Landscape Convention**

"This convention ...covers


natural, rural, urban and peri-urban areas.


It includes land, inland water and marine areas.


It concerns landscapes that might be considered outstanding as well as everyday or degraded landscapes.

# The European Landscape Convention

#### General Measures:

...C

to establish procedures for the **participation of the general public**, local and regional authorities, and other parties with an interest in the definition and implementation of the landscape policies.....

The convention basically wants landscape to be on the political agendas.

It does not tell us in detail how to do this (subsidiary principle).

Democracy basically means that the power is within the people.


Most democratic countries are governed as representative democracies.



The dillema of a representative democracy is the danger of loosing confidence of the people ,on the ground in the course of the election periods.

Local knowledge might be relevant for making reasonable decisions.





# Interaction 2 - If you said yes, why?






Germany 2013: Stuttgart 21 protests were a result of lacking involvement of the public and yet: the referendum result was in favour the project.




# The rationalist approach did not succeed Shift to discourse-oriented processes in policy and planning

#### Landscape action as policy arrangement




Policy arrangement visualized as a tetrahedron from Duncan Liefferink (2006).
