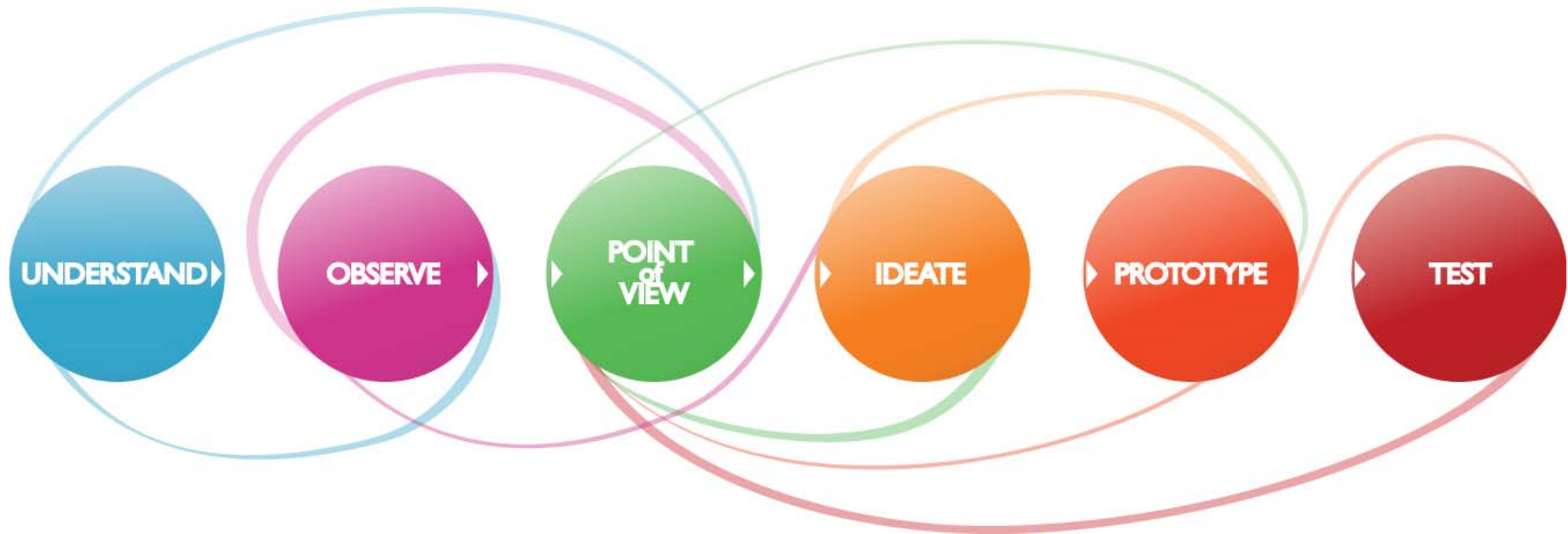

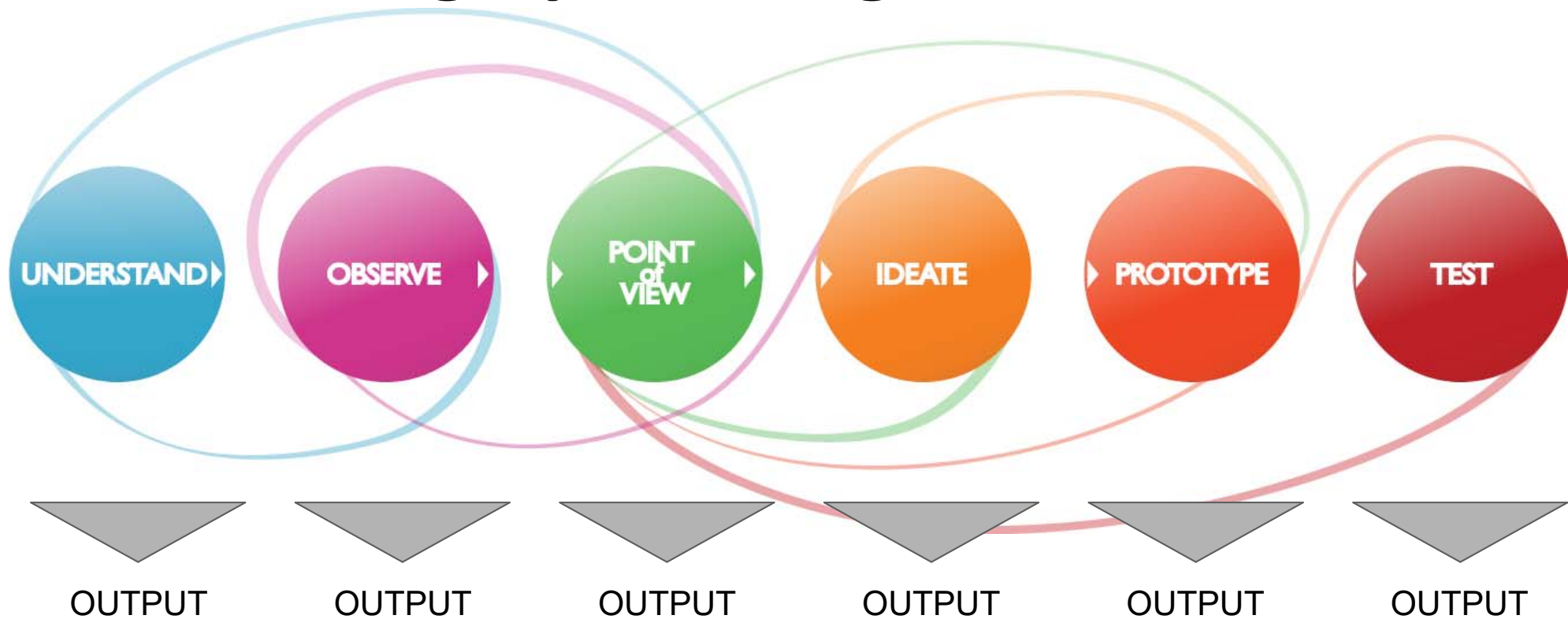

The Design Thinking Process

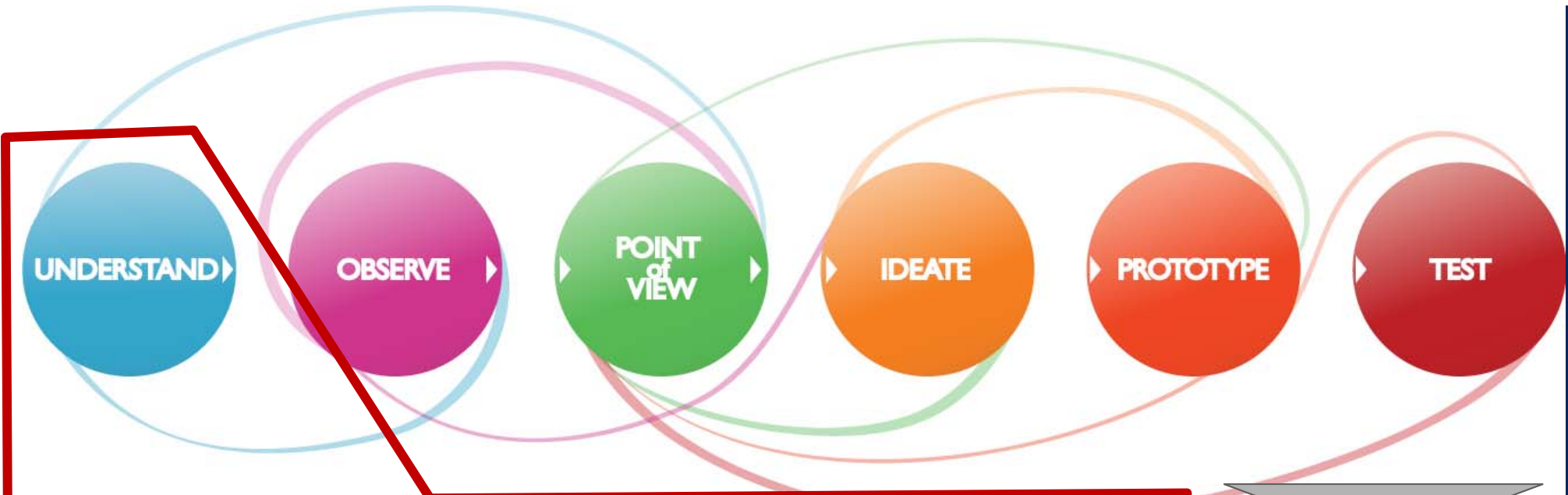

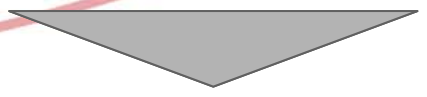
The design process generates OUTPUT

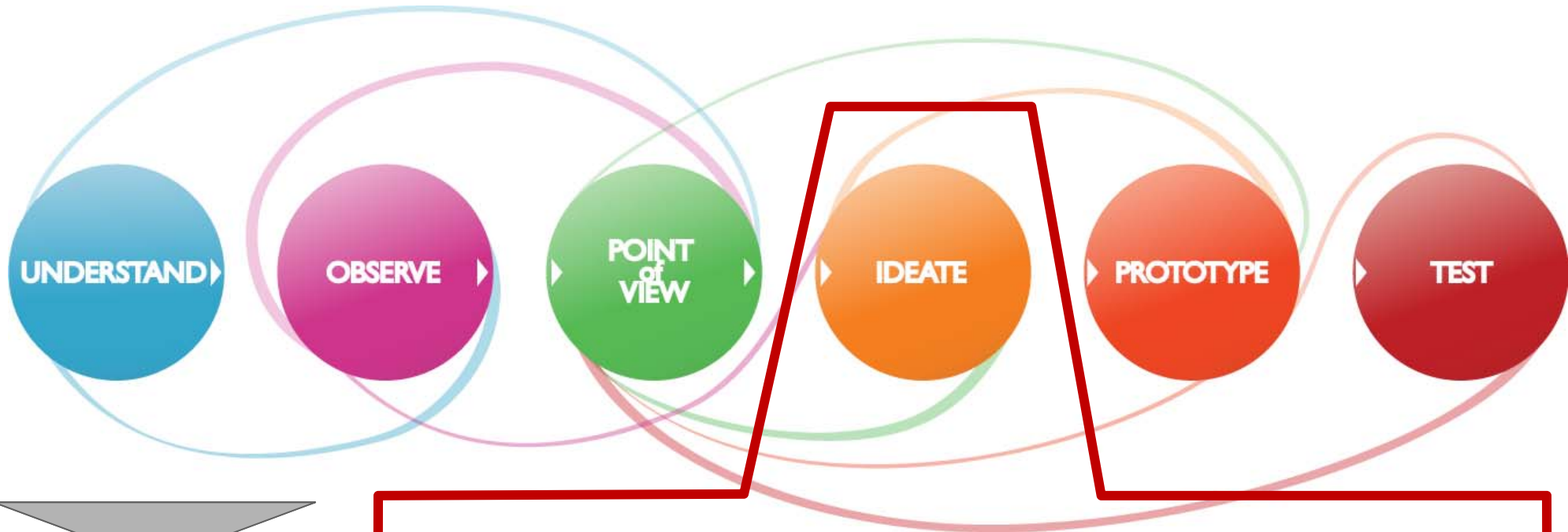

Gather Data. Document all ideas. Visualize. Find patterns ... Go out, ask again.

Output: e.g.
Statistics out of surveys, interviews, data warehouses, ...with graphs.
Different structures, like hierarchies, prioritizations, ...of the data

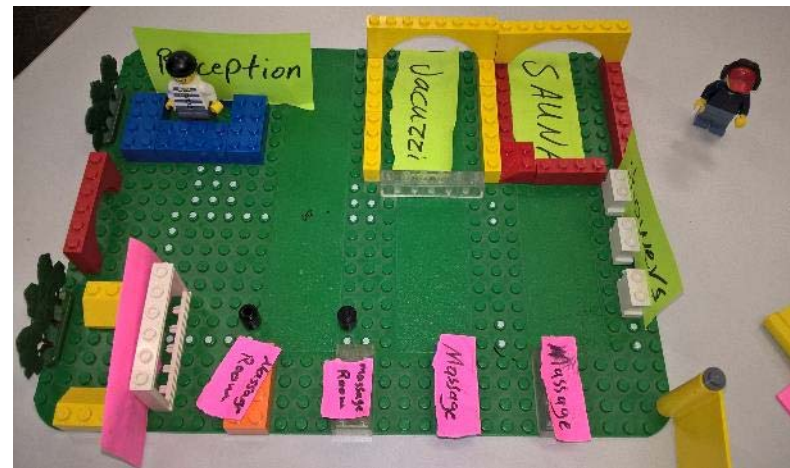

Do not go into solutions too early

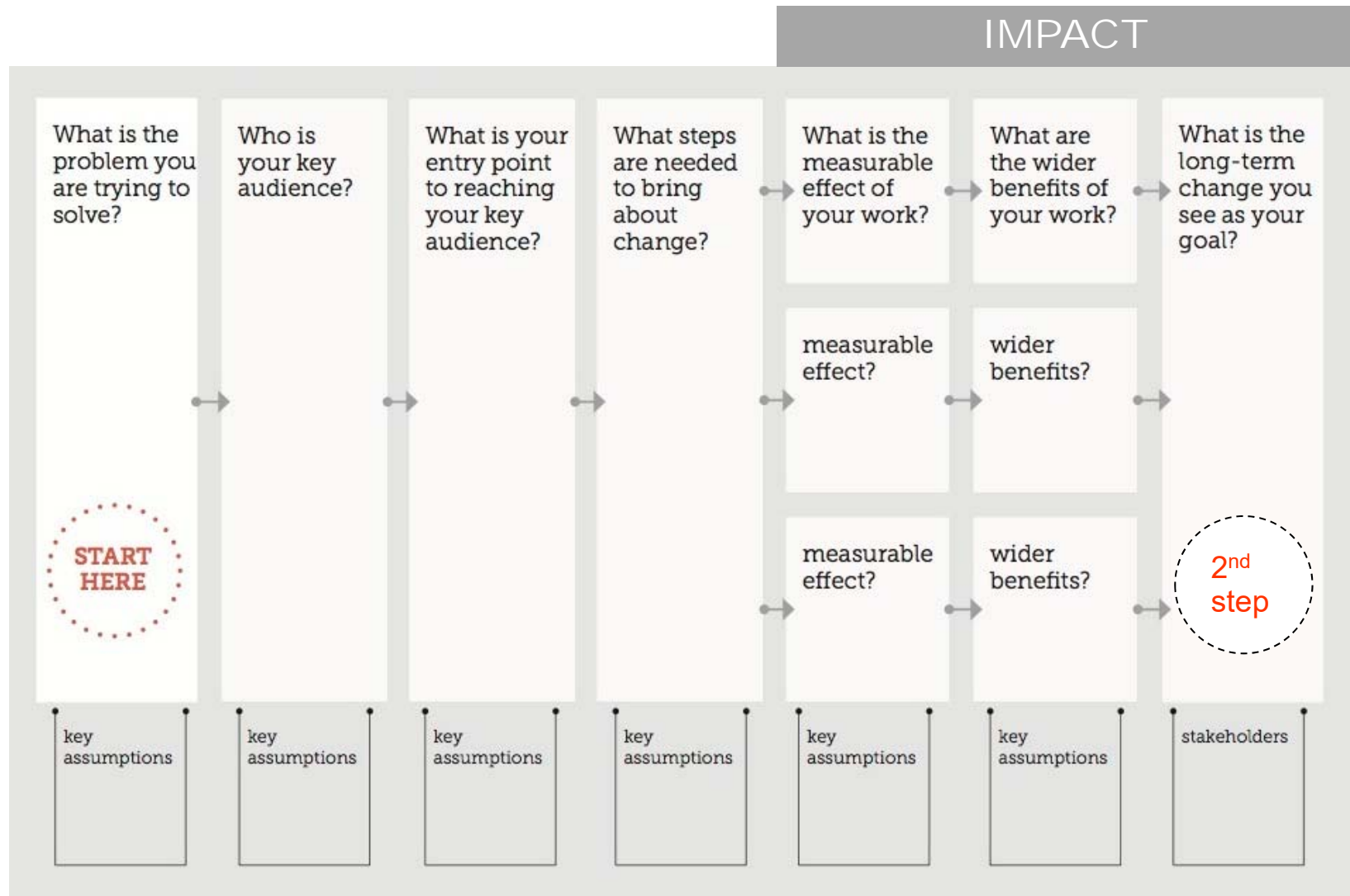
Ask 5 x times WHY: WHY? WHY? WHY? WHY?

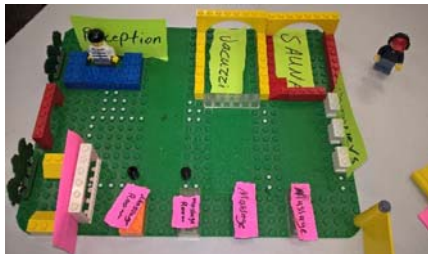

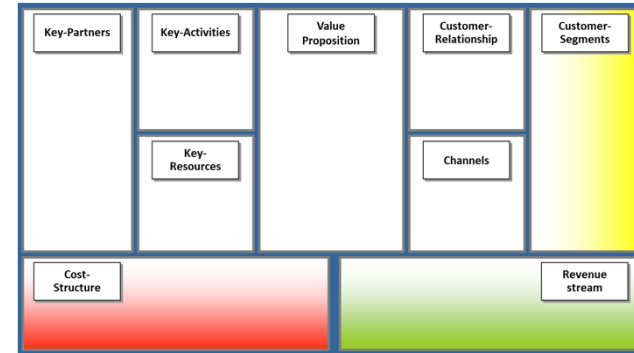
