



The Design Thinking Process






Ask WHY 5 x times



Gather Data. Document all ideas. Visualize. Find patterns ... Go out, ask again.

Output: e.g.
Statistics out of surveys, interviews, data warehouses, ...with graphs.
 Different structures, like hierarchies, prioritizations,...of the data



What are the challenges?go deeper – understand better – ask WHY


Do not go into solutions too early






