

Here you find some additional typs

- Again NEVER overwrite an existing file (unless it is your own)
 - Try to name your file without space use other symbol instead of it e.g. _
 - With fix widhts and heights you influence the preview of the image. If you click on it you are going to see the image in the original uploaded size.
 - If you edit the wikipage, use the codes from the given templates
 - In case of group work only one person should edit the page at a time, otherwise the program will mix up the savings from different people from different computers. (But its not a problem if you work on different wiki links at the same time.)
 - If the image is not yours, please add the source of it as a reference!
