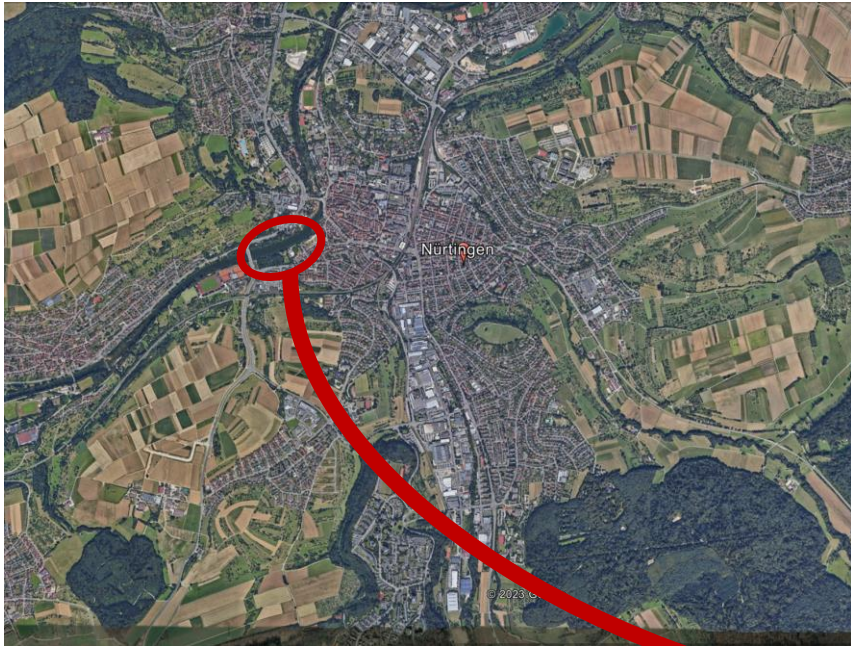

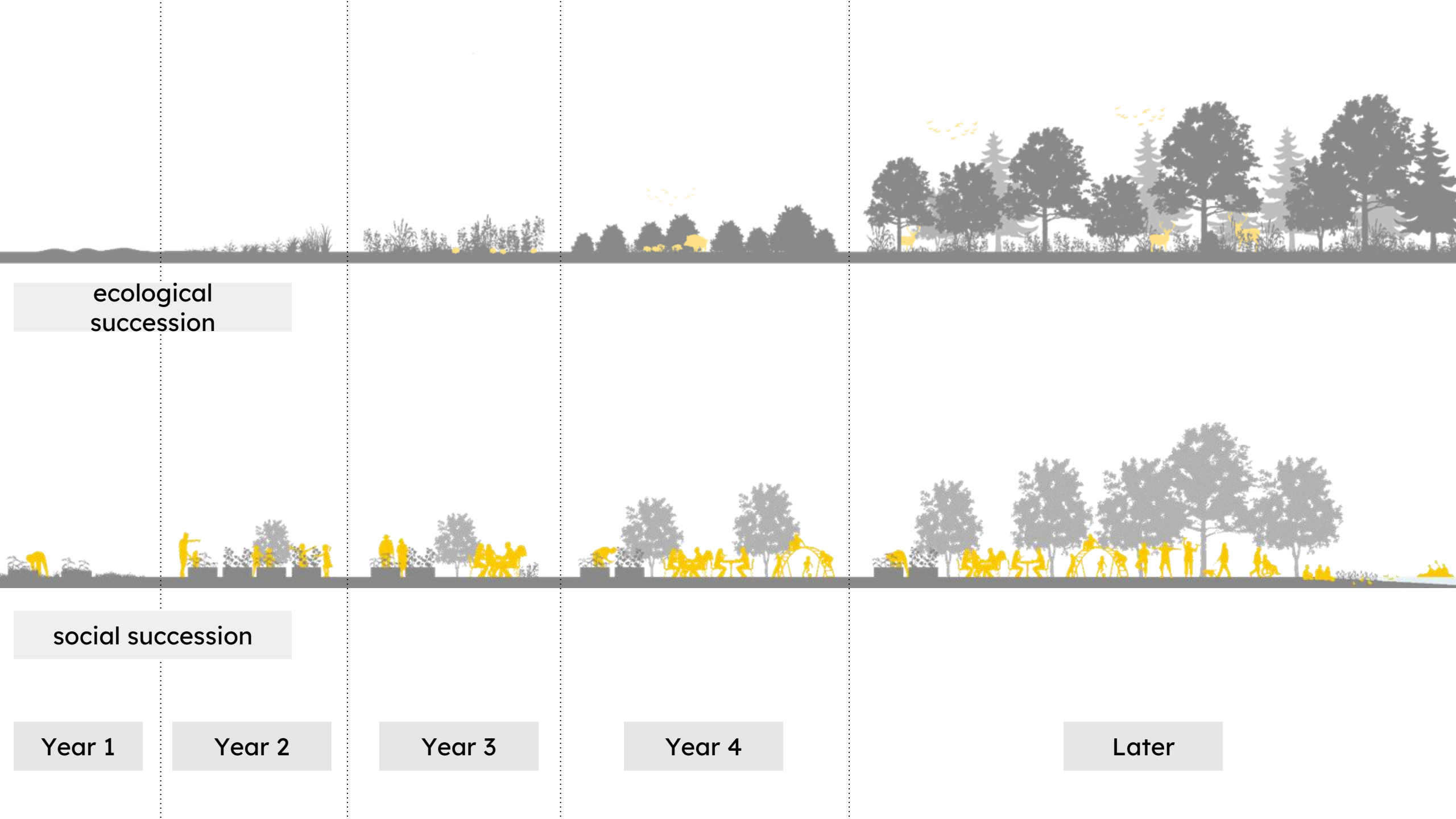

2. enhance infrastructure: develop well-designed infrastructure to accommodate diverse activities including areas designated for sports and relaxation



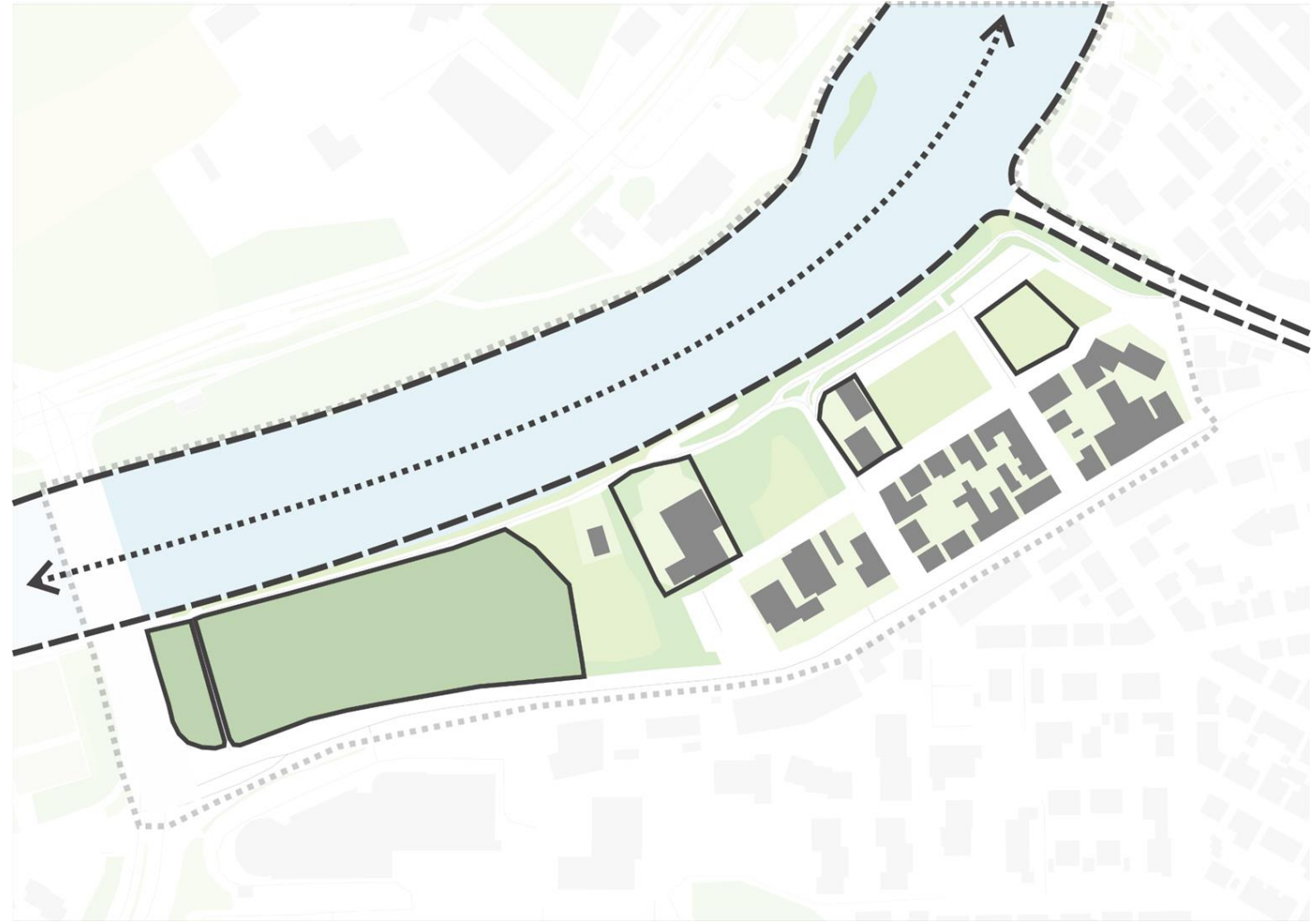
A Park by the People, For the People

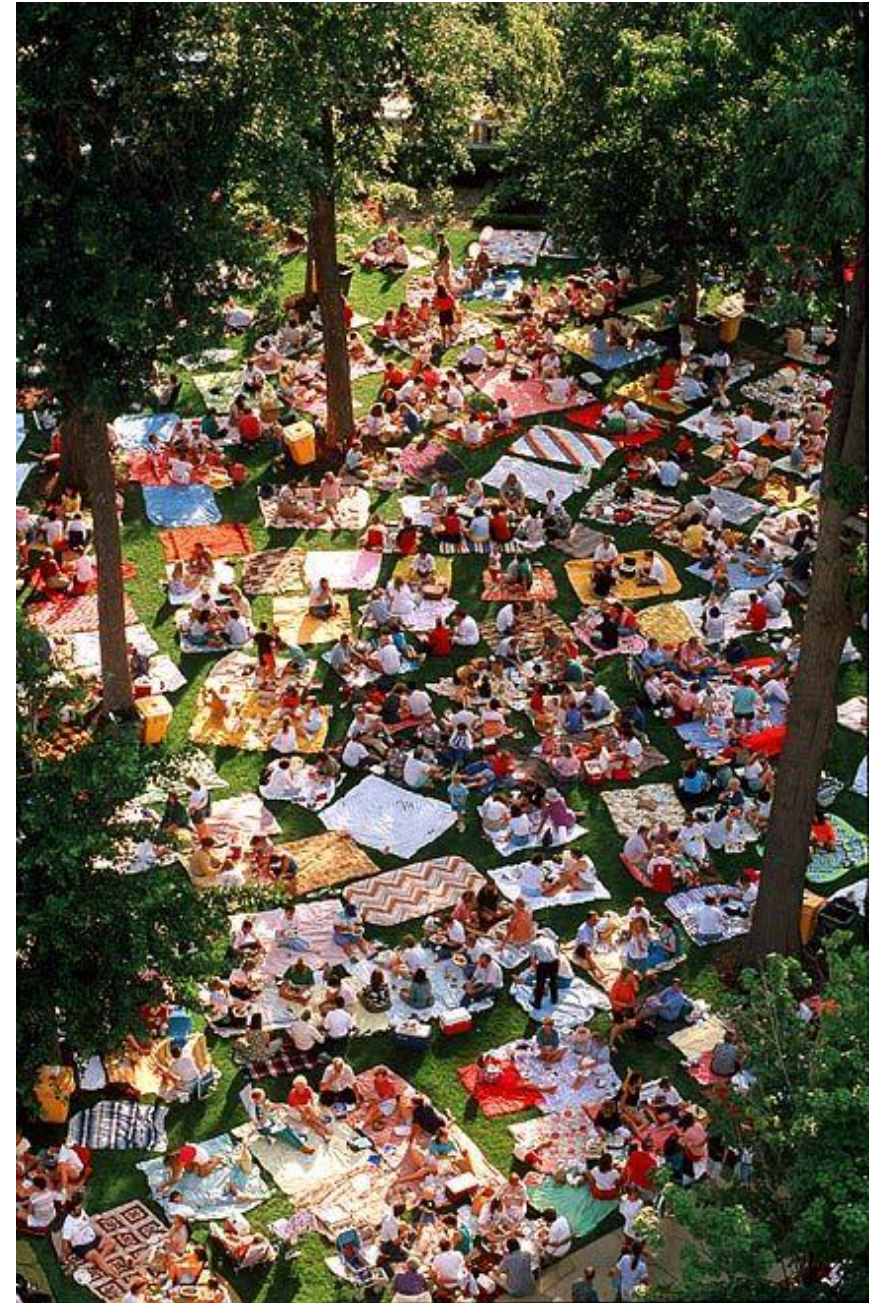

 - Start charging remaining parking (2€ per hour - **€80,000** a year)



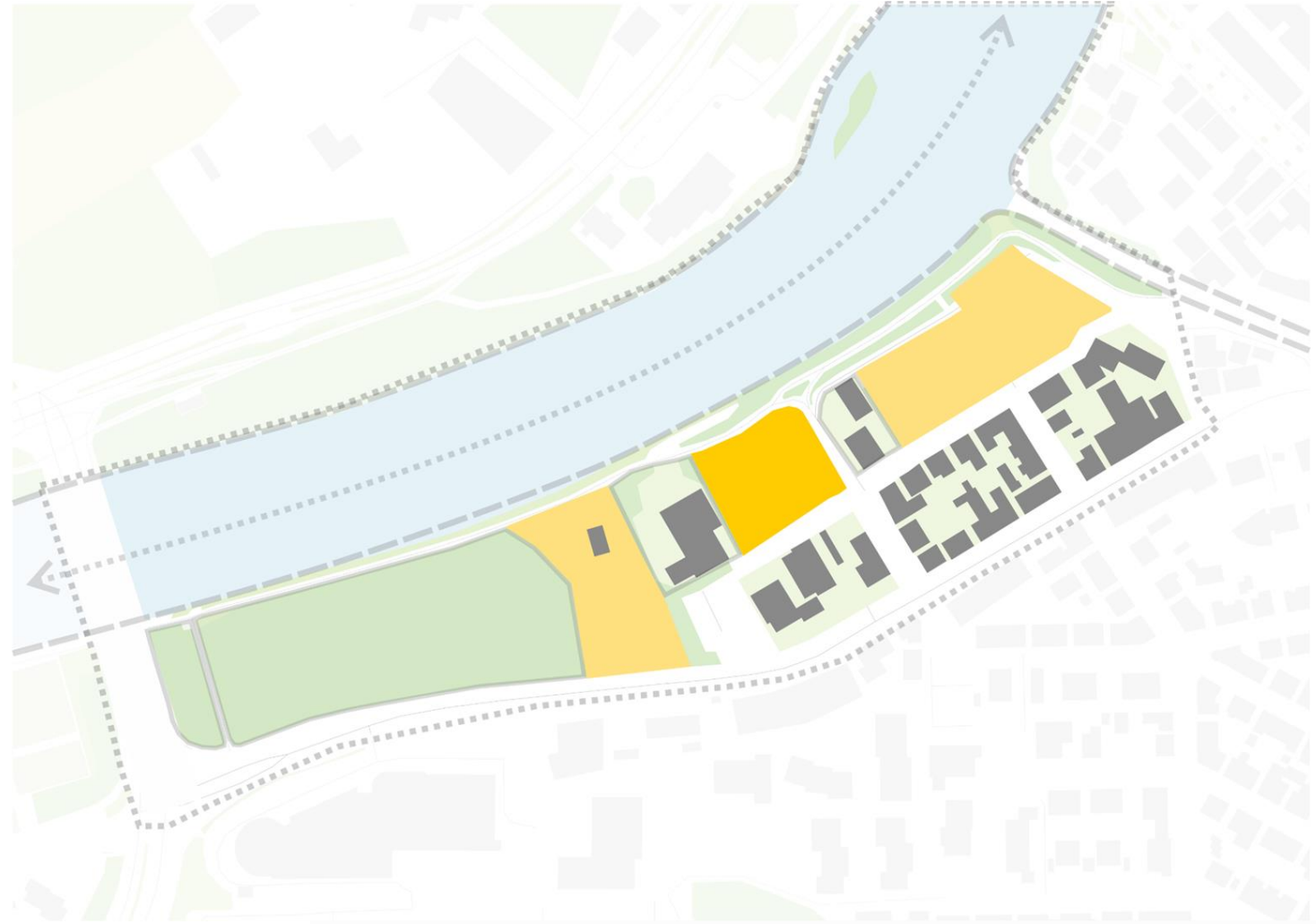
Year 3

€15,000



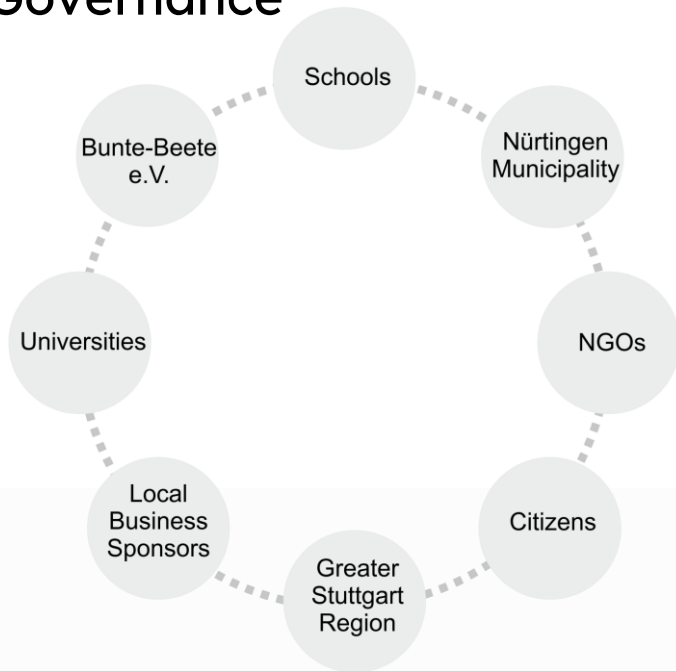
Year 4

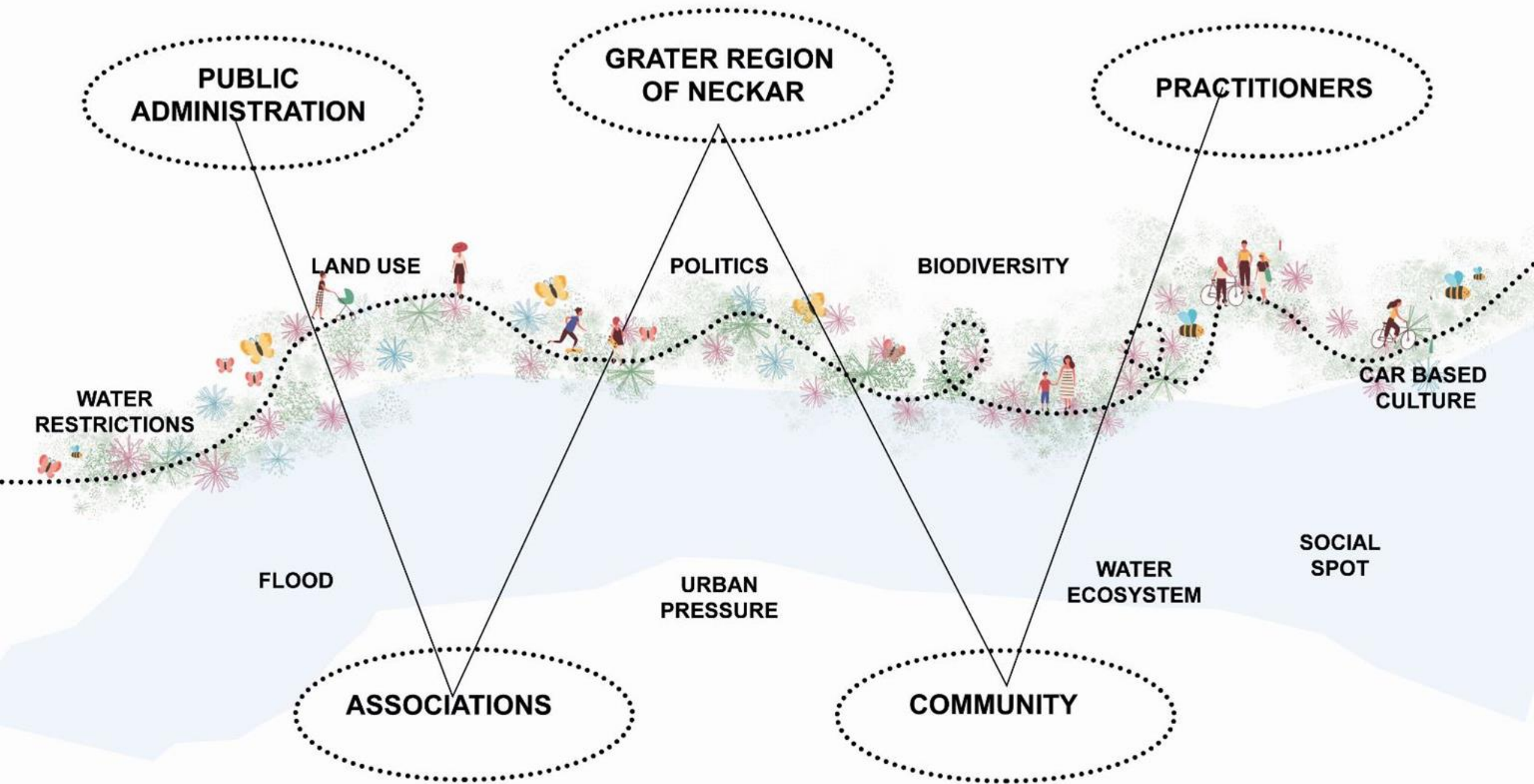

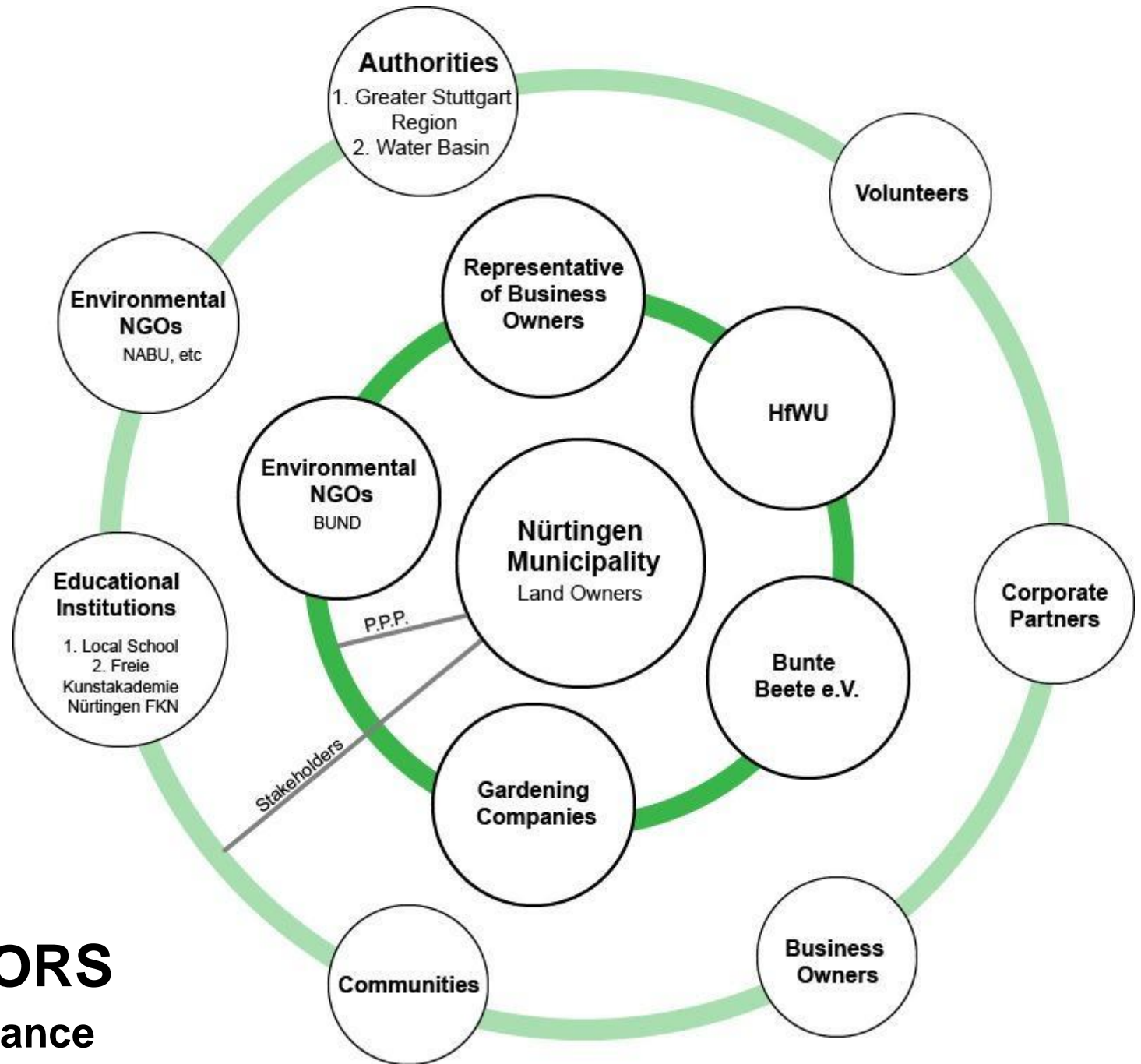
