




Elaionas used to be an olive grove, hence the name Eleonas

A new Landscape Governance Model for Elaionas



The vision of the Elaionas Landscape Council

Our vision is a healthy, inclusive and resilient Eleonas landscape that leaves nobody behind during the regeneration process.

At the heart of this landscape we see the forgotten and hidden **rivers**. They will become ecological, social, climatic and cultural **corridors**.

Eleonas will have a powerful **green infrastructure network** that supports its social, ecological and cultural **regeneration**.

We see a landscape of circular and **regenerative production** that provides opportunities for many including the **most vulnerable** and deprived. Eleonas **stands together** for a common future.

The mission of the Elaionas Landscape Council

We do this through the innovative and landscape-based governance of the Elaionas Landscape Council. Our Council is formed by representatives of **all five municipalities** belonging to the Elaionas plain.

Our Council is steered by **democratically legitimated goals and principles** that are in line with its vision.

This informs the **strategy-building**, **landscape development planning** and **co-funding** of transformative designs and practices in Elaionas.


The council works in close collaboration with local **Community Innovation Labs.** These labs operate at the interface of **science**, **people and landscape**. They provide **inclusive entry points** to diverse social groups.

They can become an active part of the democratic landscape transformation of Elaionas.


Principles of the Elaionas Landscape Development Plan

- Activate all rivers as blue-green corridors
- Apply the **3 30 300 rule** for green infrastructure, health and climate resilience
- Create a connected and multifunctional **green infrastructure network**
- Keep the productive landscape in a new form: green economy, food, light & circular fabrication, clean & decarbonised
- Envision a **new modal split:** 30% car, 40% public transport, 30% cycling
 & foot
- Enhance the **antique heritage**: Via Sacra and Olive Grove
- No more soil sealing. Regenerate 30% of the sealed surface
- Develop residential functions and affordable housing
- Built **new university facilities** on places that need transformation
- Use Community Innovation Labs to test principles and activate capacity



Cross-section of the river in 2024




- Lot of cars

- Adding trees and plants to the side of the river




Cross-section of the river in 2060

- Plant trees and plants on the "traffic island"




