

A BLENDED LEARNING CONCEPT FOR COLLABORATION, INNOVATION AND CULTURAL DIALOGUE

CONDITIONS AND CREDITS

Academic recognition for successful completion will be as follows with a maximum of 7 ECTS: up to 5 ECTS for the online seminar (active participation), up to 7

> ECTS for those who attend both the online course and the intensive study programme. Successful participation n the online part is a requirement for participating in the Arnhem workshop. However, participation in the workshop is limited. Each consortium university can offer seven grants, covering travel and subsistence. There is no limit regarding the number of participants in the online course. Any interested student, graduate or young professional is invited to attend. All participants who

successfully complete the assignments will be issued a certificate on behalf of the five academic institutions involved. Passive, listen-only participation in the online course is also possible, but no certificate will be issued for this participation mode

Social Entrepreneurship for Local Change is an ERASMUS+ Strategic Partnership with the following core activities

OUTPUT 1: ONLINE COURSE

The Social Entrepreneurship learning materials will be embedded into a blended learning concept consisting of self-study phases, virtual classroom sessions with peers/experts and virtual team work with fellow students in other parts of Europe and beyond

OUTPUT 2:REPORT

The report is addressed to academic teaching staff and intends to support teachers in integrating social entrepreneurship into higher education teaching and learning. Relevant topics such as the course design, competence oriented assessment and virtual team work concepts will be presented to enhance the use of e-learning for collaborative and interactive learning settings

LEARNING ACTIVITIES

The online course will run three times to allow for extensive testing, evaluation and revision. The course is complemented by intensive study programmes which will be held in Bucharest, Romania (2016), Arnhem, Netherlands (2017) and Tartu, Estonia.
