

Lagos is a commercially vibrant place. Housing is mostly mixed use and people try to use up all their land space leaving little or no room for green areas.




Over 85% of the population in Lagos live in metropolitan Lagos and their population is not less than 8 million.(LASG)

As at the 2005 master plan review 52% of Lagos is for residential use. This translates to 10,341 hectares of the total built up area in Lagos.

The process used to conduct the research was summarised in a research process which is expressed in a flow chart shown below.



The results showed that a medium density estate In Lagos – Atunrase Estate has Domestic Source Carbon Emissions (DSCEs) of about 176,904kg per year. (Williams, 2011) By statistical extrapolations if this amount is taken as a representative DSCEs for all residential Area types, the state has about 353,808,000 kg of DSCEs per year.

will be embarked upon by a pilot phase of distributing and planting 5,000 trees across Lagos and enlisting residents commitment to nurture these trees and hence become the primary beneficiaries of the green card.



3,000 TREES HAVE BEEN PLANTED, SO WE HAVE **2,000** TREES TO GO TO FULFILL THE PILOT PHASE OF THIS INITIATIVE.

The first thing I did Was to organise a campaign launch to make A statement of what I wanted to do as Environment Ambassador. I informed the government and got their key personnel to attend.

The initiative suffered an initial set back in terms of financing but I was not deterred. I pressed forward and modified our strategy to yet achieve her goals. This was done by organising TREE FESTIVALS in Religious congregations where Environment talks are given to explain the importance of tree planting and why Government is planting trees and tree seedlings were distributed free of charge to the congregants and in return enlisting their commitment to planting the tree after they had given their contact information. Also, Environment seminars were held in the private High schools and an Environment Club was inaugurated and Tree planting project commissioned as the club's first project.
